## **1. Is Public Narrative the same as Public Speaking?**

No, Public Narrative is not the same as Public Speaking. Public Narrative is a leadership framework that enables you to communicate your purpose and values through stories to inspire and motivate people to take action.

## **2. Why do I need to submit a 2-minute video in my application?**

Public Narrative training requires you to reflect on your purpose and values. Therefore, we would like you to start on this process by submitting a video.

## **3. What content should I include in the 2-minute video?**

For us to get to know you, please describe a moment when you faced a challenge in your life. What were your choices? Why did you make that choice? What is the outcome? Through this story, we will get to know your values. You can also take a look at a couple of examples in the application form.

## **4. How much time do I need to commit to this course?**

You will spend approximately three hours reading the guide, completing the quizzes, watching videos, and recording your stories on videos. The first video is due on **9/28** and the second video is on **10/17**. On top of that you will spend about 8 hours on Zoom for the three classes. During the training, you are expected to be in a quiet place, turn on your camera and fully participate. You will not be able to multi-task during this course.

## **5. Would it be possible for me to miss one of the classes and still participate?**

Your participation is essential not only to your learning but also to the people in the course. Therefore, you are required to participate in all three classes.
